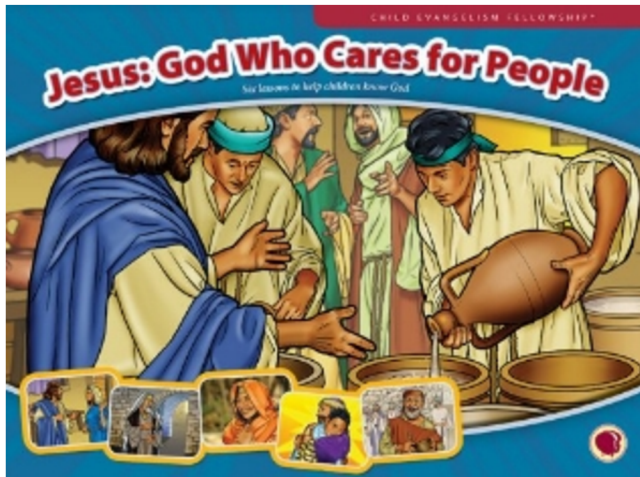




JESUS: GOD WHO CARES FOR PEOPLE *series overview*

Lesson 1

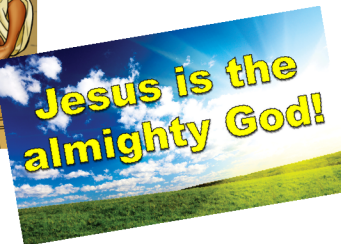
Jesus Shows He is the Almighty God

Memory Verse: John 3:16

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life."

Jesus showed His amazing power at a wedding by turning ordinary water into the very best wine, proving He is no ordinary man but the mighty Son of God. This miracle helped the disciples see that Jesus has power over all things because He is truly God. When we trust Him, He can change our lives just like He changed the water—making us new and showing His love and glory. (John 2:1-11)

Lesson 2 Nicodemus Can't Save Himself

Memory Verse: John 3:16

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life."



Nicodemus came to Jesus wanting to understand God's truth, and Jesus told him that everyone needs to be "born again," because our hearts are dead in sin. Only Jesus can give us new life, and this new life comes from trusting Him and the work He came to do. God loved the world so much that He sent His only Son so that anyone who believes in Him will be made alive forever. (John 3:1-16)

Jesus met a woman at a well and showed her that He knew everything about her life, yet He still loved her and offered her the "living water" that only He can give. When she realized who Jesus was—the Savior—she believed in Him and ran to tell others the good news. Many people in her town believed in Jesus too, reminding us that He knows us completely, loves us deeply, and came to save everyone who trusts in Him. (John 4:1-30; 39-42)

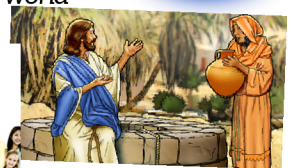
Jesus Loves Everyone

Lesson 4

Jesus Heals the Nobleman's Son

Memory Verse: John 3:36

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him."

A royal official came to Jesus begging Him to heal his sick son, and Jesus told him to go home because his son would live. The man believed Jesus' words even before he saw the miracle, and on his way home he learned that his son was healed at the exact moment Jesus spoke. This reminds us that Jesus is the only Savior who has the power to give life, and we can believe every promise God gives. (John 4:46-54)

Lesson 5

Jesus Cares for Bartimaeus

Memory Verse: John 3:36

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him."



A blind man called out to Jesus for help, believing that Jesus was the only one who could show him mercy and make him whole. Jesus listened to him, healed his eyes, and showed that He has the power to save and the kindness to care for anyone who comes to Him. The man immediately praised God and followed Jesus, reminding us that we can trust Jesus to forgive our sin and joyfully thank Him for His great mercy. (Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43)
