Assignment #4 – Prayer/Family Time

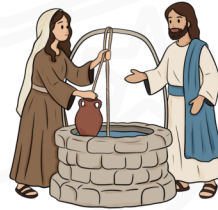
Week 1 - Thank Jesus for His power and love with.
