1. Read 1 Samuel 17:45-47
Why was David confident?
2. Write five truths about God that help you be brave.
3. Be bold and share your faith with someone.

Lesson 4 - Trust God's Plan (MV - 119:11)

1. Draw a path from "Problem" to "God's Plan." Along the path, write 3 ways God helps us trust Him.
2. Write something you're waiting for. How can you trust God while you wait?
3. Retell the Bible story to a family member.

Lesson 5 - God's Heart of Kindness (MV - 119:9-11)

1. Read 2 Samuel 9:1-13
2. Complete 3 acts of kindness (Help someone, encourage someone, and share with someone)
3. Draw a picture of Mephibosheth eating at the King's table. Tell someone how this teaches us about God's kindness.
